DFK Canada is pleased to introduce two social outings on the afternoon of Thursday, June 8th between 3:00 and 6:00 p.m. Advance registration is required.

Option #1 -Hiking Tour of Tunnel Mountain

Cost: Free (Pre-Registration online is required)

Located only 10 minutes from the hotel, the hike to Tunnel Mountain is certainly an old one but a good one and has been around since the early days of Banff National Park. The trail is well maintained, easy to access, and ideal for visitors. A panoramic view from the top of the town site, the Bow Valley and Mt. Rundle make this the perfect "get-to-know-the-area" excursion.

Time: 2-3 hours Distance: 4.3 km (2.7 miles) round-trip Level of Difficulty: Easy Elevation Gain: 300 m (948 feet)



Option # 2 – Banff Tour and Gondola Ride Up Sulphur Mountain

Cost: \$100 per person (pre-registration online is required)

Enjoy a sightseeing tour of the Banff area including a ride up the Banff Gondola for a panoramic 3600 view of the town site and surrounding area. Other highlights of the tour include Surprise Corner, the hoodoos - shaped by centuries of wind and Tunnel Mountain Drive that overlooks the splendour of the Bow River Valley. Includes private transportation, Tour Guide/Coordinator, Banff Gondola admission
